

### **Early Psychosis Intervention Program**

EPI is based on the Early Assessment Support Team from Salem, Oregon. The program provides services for young people between the ages of 12 and 25 who are at risk for serious mental illnesses. The program includes community education to increase awareness of signs and symptoms and early access to screening, assessment, education, treatment and supports for young people and their families. By getting help early, an individual's chances greatly improve for staying in school, working, maintaining friendships and planning for the future. The implementing partner will be required to provide bilingual Spanish/English early intervention services as well as community education. Materials used for public education will be developed in Spanish as well as English. Attention to local needs will need to be balanced with fidelity the model.
