

CPP is a component of the Mental Health Services Act

Participatory process, requiring community collaboration to:

- a)Assess current capacity
- b)Define populations to be served

Strategize: Determine strategies to provide effective programs that are:

- a)Culturally Relevant
- b)Client and Family Driven
- o c) Wellness, Recovery and Resilience-focused
- d)Integrated: Provide an Integrated Service Experience for Clients & Families
